

The East Niceville Fire District (ENFD) is governed by the Florida Code of Ethics for Public Officers and Employees, adopted by the Legislature as [Part III of Chapter 112, Florida Statutes](#), which contains standards of ethical conduct and disclosures applicable to public officers, employees, and candidates.

Additionally, ENFD public officers and employees are governed by the "Sunshine Amendment," adopted by Florida voters through a constitutional initiative in 1976 as [Article II, Section 8, Florida Constitution](#), which contains standards of ethical conduct and disclosures applicable to local government entities.

All elected state and local public officers, including ENFD Commissioners and Pension Fund Trustees, are required to file an annual financial disclosure form IAW Sections [112.3144](#) and [112.3145](#), Florida Statutes. Financial disclosure is required in order to enable the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deter corruption, and increase public confidence in government.
