This operating instruction establishes when and where fire department uniforms may be worn.

A. <u>General</u>

1. Personnel will report for duty in uniform, i.e. pants and uniform shirt or golf shirt.

2. All line personnel will wear a uniform while on duty.

3. Personnel will wear a complete uniform when out in the public except when performing fatigue duties. The coveralls or trousers with "T" shirt is an acceptable uniform when performing fatigue duties.

4. For special or formal occasions, the dress uniform will be worn, or the uniform shirt with navy blue tie.

B. <u>Restrictions</u>

1. Uniform items will not be worn with civilian clothing except the lightweight windbreaker.

2. The coveralls will not be worn in public except when performing fatigue duties or at an emergency.

3. Uniform items that become worn, faded, torn or otherwise unserviceable will be turned into the supply officer for a replacement item.

C. Duty Uniform

1. Fire Chief, Assistant Fire Chief - white shirt and blue trousers. The gray trousers may be worn with a golf shirt.

2. Captains – white uniform shirt or golf shirt with dark blue trousers.

3. Firefighters – blue uniform shirt or golf shirt and blue trousers.

D. Special Occasions

1. All personnel – dress uniform.
